Application of this arrangement

This UK Client to The Mediation Specialists International Data Transfer Arrangement applies automatically to each UK Client to The Mediation Specialists & Co International Data Transfer.

UK Client to The Mediation Specialists International Data Transfer

A UK Client to The Mediation Specialists International Data Transfer is a transfer of personal data by, or on behalf of, one of our clients established in the United Kingdom (UK Client) to a Mediation Specialists Entity which, but for the application of this UK Client to The Mediation Specialists International Data Transfer Arrangement to the transfer, would be prohibited under the data protection laws that apply to the UK Client.

The Mediation Specialists' Entities

Mediation Specialists Ltd (trading as The Mediation Specialists) together with any entity (including any individual, partnership, company, limited liability partnership or other body corporate or unincorporate) established or practising in any jurisdiction and authorised by Mediation Specialists Ltd to include in its name 'The Mediation Specialists' or to describe itself as 'in association with' The Mediation Specialists" in the provision of mediation, training and consultancy services to clients introduced to the Entity by The Mediation Specialists.

Additional clauses that apply in respect of the UK Client to The Mediation Specialists' Entities International Data Transfer.

The EU's standard contractual clauses for the transfer of personal data from the European Community to third countries (controller to controller transfers) set out in Commission Decision 2004/915/EC, as amended from time to time by the data protection laws of the United Kingdom (EU Controller to Controller Model Clauses) shall apply.

This UK Client to The Mediation Specialists' Entities International Data Transfer Arrangement supplements any other arrangements the UK Client and The Mediation Specialists have in place in relation to the processing of personal data – such as the data protection provisions set out in The Mediation Specialists' Entity's Terms of Business. To the extent that there is any conflict or inconsistency between the terms of the EU Controller to Controller Model Clauses and any other arrangement that the UK Client and The Mediation Specialists' Entity have in place in relation to the processing of personal data, the terms of the EU Controller to Controller Model Clauses shall take precedence.

Completing the details needed for the EU Controller to Controller Model Clauses for the UK Client to The Mediation Specialists' Entities International Data Transfer

For the purposes of the EU Controller to Controller Model Clauses:

- the UK Client will be the data exporter and The Mediation Specialists' Entity will be the data importer;
- in relation to Clause II(h) of the EU Controller to Controller Model Clauses, the UK Client and The Mediation Specialists' Entity elect to comply with the provisions of sub-Clause II(h)(iii);
- in relation to Clause II(i) of the EU Controller to Controller Model Clauses, the UK Client acknowledges that The Mediation Specialists' Entity has given appropriate notice to the UK Client about onward transfers of the personal data to the recipients described in this table that are data controllers located outside of the United Kingdom or the European Economic Area; and
- the description of the UK Client to The Mediation Specialists' Entities International Data Transfer for the purposes of Annex B of the EU Controller to Controller Model Clauses is as set out below:

Data subjects: The personal data transferred concern the following categories of data subjects

The personal data transferred under the UK Client to The Mediation Specialists' Entities International Data Transfer will concern one or more of the following categories of data subjects:

- individuals that are the UK Client or that work for, own or represent the UK Client;
- individuals that work for, own or represent the UK Client's service providers;
- individuals that are either directly or indirectly involved or connected with, or relevant to, a matter on which The Mediation Specialists Entity is providing mediation, consultancy or training services to the UK Client (either directly or indirectly); and
- individuals whose details are transferred to The Mediation Specialists Entity in connection with our role as the provider of services on behalf of the UK Client.

Purposes of the transfer(s): The transfer is made for the following purposes

The UK Client to The Mediation Specialists' Entities International Data Transfer is made for one or more of the following main purposes:

- to provide the UK Client with mediation, consultancy and/or training services
- to manage and develop The Mediation Specialists' business with the UK Client, which may include using the personal data for marketing purposes where relevant; and

• to comply with The Mediation Specialists' entities, and the wider Mediation Specialists group's, legal and regulatory requirements. Full details of the purposes for which The Mediation Specialists' Entity may use the personal data are set out in The Mediation Specialists' privacy notice, a copy of which can be found at www.themediationspecialists.org.uk .

Categories of data: The personal data transferred concern the following categories of data

The UK Client to The Mediation Specialists' Entities International Data Transfer will include the transfer of one or more of the following categories of personal data:

- individual details – name, address (including proof of address), other contact details (e.g. email and telephone numbers), gender, marital status, date and place of birth, nationality, employer, job title and employment history, and family details, including their relationship to the data subject;
- identification details – identification numbers relating to the data subject issued by government bodies or agencies, such as national insurance numbers, social security numbers, passport numbers, tax identification numbers and driving licence numbers;
- financial information – bank account or payment card details, income or other financial information about the data subject;
- matter details – information about the data subject which is relevant to a matter on which The Mediation Specialists is providing a service to the UK Client;
- credit, anti-fraud and sanctions data – credit history, credit score and information received from various anti-fraud and sanctions databases relating to the data subject; and
- identifiers – information which can be traced back to the data subject, such as an IP address, a website tracking code or electronic images of the data subject

Recipients: The personal data transferred may be disclosed only to the following recipients or categories of recipients

The personal data may be disclosed by The Mediation Specialists' Entity to a number of third parties in connection with the purposes of the UK Client to The Mediation Specialists' Entities International Data Transfer – including to other Mediation Specialists' Entities.

Sensitive data: (if appropriate) The personal data transferred concern the following categories of sensitive data:

Where relevant, the UK Client to The Mediation Specialists' International Data Transfer may include the transfer of the following categories of sensitive data:

Special categories of personal data: information about health, racial or ethnic origin; political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs; trade union membership; genetic and biometric data; and information about a person's sex life or sexual orientation, in each case where relevant to the purposes of the transfer. Criminal convictions data: information relating to criminal convictions and offences.
